## Results

The abstract deadline is June 2024. If you live in a low- or middle-income country (LMICs) and you wish to apply for a travel grant, you can indicate so below. Please note that travel grants will be assigned after the abstract selection process uniquely to researchers whose abstract has been accepted either for an oral or poster presentation. Please find the complete list of eligible LMICs following the link provided on the conference website.

## **Discussion and conclusions**

You can indicate your preferred choice of presentation below (oral or poster). Please note that there is limited time for oral presentations, therefore the scientific committee reserves the right to change the type of presentation from oral to poster. A selected number of posters will be chosen for short oral poster pitches (1 minute each).
